270023aa French 1 SV 1 Credit Grades 9-12

French 1 is a study of the French language and culture. Students will learn listening and speaking skills including understanding and responding to simple directions, expressions of courtesy, and questions related to daily routines. Students will develop their reading and writing skills including words and phrases used in basic situational contexts. Students will acquire a beginning understanding of French-speaking cultures. Regular at-home practice is required daily.

French 2 is a continuation of the French 1 curriculum. Students will increase their listening and speaking skills including understanding and responding to a variety of directions, commands, and questions related to personal preferences. Reading skills will increase with comprehension of main ideas from simple texts. Writing comprehension will increase as students compose short presentations on familiar topics. Further understanding of the French-speaking culture will be continued.

Prerequisite(s): Completion of French 1 with an average of a C or higher.

French 3 is a continuation of the French 2 curriculum. Students will increase their listening and speaking skills including understanding and responding to factual and interpretive questions involving paraphrasing, explaining, and giving cause. Students will also increase their abilities in interpreting main ideas and supporting details from authentic texts and in creating oral and written presentations on a variety of topics. Increased understanding of French-speaking cultures will be continued.

Prerequisite(s): Completion of French 2 with an average of B or higher.

French 4 is a continuation of the French 3 curriculum. Students will increase their listening and speaking skills. Standards include understanding and responding to factual and interpretive questions, proposing and supporting solutions to issues and problems, interpreting authentic prose and poetry selections, creating literary compositions, and building an extensive understanding of French-speaking cultures.

Prerequisite(s): Completion of French 3 with an average of B or higher.
